## Notes for Public Hearing Participants

- Applicants must (1) state their affiliation, name, and contact information when making inquiries, and (2) show their identity (e.g., employee ID card, student ID card, etc.) on the day of the hearing.
- · Applicants are not permitted to film or record the public hearings.
- If an inappropriate act is found during the public hearing, the chief examiner of each screening committee may ask the participant to leave the room or call for communication cutoff.
- In the case of online implementation, those who wish to participate should refrain from disseminating information about the online meeting information to others. Also, make sure participants camera is on when attending the hearing.
